

Why Do We Bless the Backpacks?

Sometime in late October of 1992, my family moved from La Porte, Texas (just outside of Houston) 90 miles east to Beaumont, TX. My dad had taken a new call to a congregation there. So we pulled up stakes and made Beaumont and Bethlehem Lutheran Church our new home for the next 14 years. I was in the fourth grade, and the move was pretty hard on me. I liked our new house and I loved a lot about the new church too, but I was having a hard time in school. New teachers, new buildings, new lesson plans, new routines to learn, an entire slew of new kids; and of course to them, I was the new kid. While the bullying and social tension I experienced probably wasn't any worse than what the average kinda nerdy new kid endured at our school, it felt absolutely brutal to me. As much as I loved subjects like science, history, and reading, I dreaded going to school and seeing the sneering faces of kids who just couldn't seem to like me.

It got better. Over the weeks, months, and years I made friends, I was encouraged by my parents and able to express some of what I was going through to them, I learned to tune out the meanness of some kids, and I adapted to the social realities of a different school in a different town. But even years later, every so often I would get a weird feeling of anxiety on a Sunday evening. It didn't matter if I had finished all my homework or even if I was looking forward to seeing my friends in first period. I still carried some of that anxiety and woundedness from my rough transition back in fourth grade.

We can't always know what is going through the minds of the children in our classroom, in our sanctuary, or even at our dinner table. We don't always know precisely what they're feeling, or why they are feeling that way. But we can give them encouragement. We can talk with them and listen to them. We can give them tools to express and process what they are feeling and how to approach problems in the future. We can pray with

them and demonstrate to them all the ways that they do not have to endure the slings and arrows of this world alone, but that they can rely on the presence of God and the love of Jesus Christ that never hesitates to enter into our suffering with us: to show us that we are loved, we are precious to Him, we are not alone in our struggles.

Blessing the backpacks is one small way that we, as a church, can show our kids that they are loved by God, precious to The Lord and to us, and that they do not go anywhere without God's love, support, and presence.

Whether you're a student, teacher, parent, professor, or just someone who prays for our young people, please bring your backpack, briefcase, or lunchbox to church this Sunday. As we bless our backpacks, we begin a covenant season of praying for each other, and encouraging our students; telling them that even in the darkest moments of life they are loved and that they will persevere and succeed!


how kind and welcoming FPC has been while they're transitioning here. Be sure to reach out and say hi when you see them!
