As I get older, I'm pretty convinced the only constant in life is change. This is certainly true for FPC. We're in a new season of life, a time of transition and opportunity, a time to gratefully reflect upon the past- taking great courage and hope at God's faithfulness to us for 115yrs, but just as importantly to look forward with fresh eyes and anticipation to the next season of life.

Transitions can be anxious times— no one likes change. But, they are also times to do some metaphorical housecleaning- to look at ourselves anew with an eye to the future. But sometimes we need others to help us see ourselves and the way forward. Vital Church Ministries is just such a group. Here are some important dates for you to mark in your calendars.

August 3-19: Anonymous online survey, 75-90 questions. There will be paper copies if you're more comfortable with pen and ink. We will also have a computer set up at the church, if you wish to do the survey there and you think you might need some help.

Sept 26-30: Onsite Interviews: A team from Vital Church Ministries, having analyzed the data gathered from the survey, will come to Fairbanks to interview members of the congregation, officers and staff.

Sept. 30: A member of the Vital Church Ministries team will preach along the themes which have emerged from the survey and interviews. After worship there will be a Town Hall meeting, where the VCM team will present their insights with a time for questions and answers.

Nov. 9: We will be given a final written report which will serve as a mirror and map giving session insights into how to pray and lead in this transitional period frame.

At some point a transitional pastor will be hired by session to serve the changes being implemented. The timing of this is unclear but session will keep the congregation in the loop. If you have questions, please ask. If we know the answers, we'll tell you. If we don't, we'll tell you that too!

In the meantime- let me tell you some exciting changes that have already been made!

New Children's Sunday School material and format is coming this Fall. We have a children's ministry coach with 40 years of experience working with us to develop a deliberate, simple, effective and inexpensive curriculum with training for teachers. This will set us up well for finding and calling a new full time Children's Minister. Even if you don't have kids, you'll be seeing these changes and if you do have kids, well- be prepared to learn along with! Please pray for and support the Children's Ministry Team- and remember Heidi Van Harper and Stephanie Rozell in your prayers as they give leadership to the Children's Ministry Team.

 Marta Conner has joined Staff as our Office Administrator. Marta is a sourdough. She and her husband Kenneth have lived in Fairbanks for 32yrs. She has worked for the University and FNSB. She loves the Lord who died and rose for her. We're all grateful to our God for his providence in Marta. She is a great addition to the ministry of FPC.




