What follows is a short summary of the decisions and actions of the Session, at the January 19, 2021 Session Meeting. The minutes of the meeting will contain a more complete record.

- The Session of First Presbyterian Church met, virtually via Zoom at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, January 19th. The meeting was opened by Ruling Elder Jim Williams with prayer and a devotion.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the agenda as presented.
- Chair of the Pastor Search Committee, Teddy Riggs Sr. provided an update on the search process to the Session. Ruling Elder Terry Reichardt led the Session in a prayer for the members of the Pastor Search Committee.
- Vital Statistics from December 15, 2020 to January 19, 2021, as well as Minutes from the December 15, 2020 Stated Session Meeting and the January 3, 2021 Called Congregational Meeting, were received. It was moved, seconded and passed to approve them as presented.
- Correspondence was received from Deacon Debra Foster (& Logan Foster) resigning their positions on the Board of Deacons. It was moved, seconded and passed to accept their resignation, with regret.
- Correspondence was received from the First Presbyterian Church of Enterprise (PCA), Enterprise, AL releasing into our care, Joe LaMagna upon us receiving him into membership. It was moved, seconded and passed to invite Joe to the February Session Meeting, in order to complete the membership process.
- David McConnell-Booher informed Session that at 11:35 am on Friday January 20th, he will be appearing before the Presbytery of Pacific Northwest to be examined and taken under care of Presbytery, in his journey towards ordination as a Teaching Elder.
- There were no Consent Calendar items.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to set the date of the Winter Semi-Annual Congregational and Corporate Meeting as Sunday, February 14, 2021 after the morning service. The meeting will include in-person and online options for attendance.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the agenda for the Winter Congregational and Corporate meeting.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to call a Special Session Meeting on Tuesday, January 26, 2021 at 7:00 pm, for the purpose of meeting the new Transitional Pastor.
- Session Ministry Teams presented written and verbal reports.
- Devotions for the February Session Meeting will be provided by Ruling Elder Keith Nore.
- Elders spent time in prayer. After making prayer requests known, elders prayed for one another and for First Presbyterian, and the meeting was adjourned, in prayer by David McConnell-Booher.
- The next Stated Session Meeting will be held on February 16, 2021 at 6:00 pm via Video Conference.
