We must always be renewing ourselves: examining our individual and collective lives, praying and listening for the Holy Spirit's guidance, identifying sin, highlighting areas of improvement, humbly asking for God to cleanse and sanctify us, and making sincere effort each day to follow (with every part of our being, every corner of our life) our Lord and Teacher, Jesus Christ.

If you made a New Year's Resolution, good for you! If you already slipped in your resolution, don't be discouraged! Remember that Jesus knows us and knows that we will sometimes stumble. Be sure to show yourself the grace and forgiveness that God pours out for you and that you show to others. If you didn't make a resolution for the new year, that's okay too. Consider this article as a prompt to pray, to reflect on your life, and to ask God how He might guide you (and how you might listen to Him) just a little bit better today, this month, this year. 



What follows is a short summary of the decisions and actions of the Session, at the December 19, 2023 Stated Session Meeting, which began at 6:00 pm in the Church Conference Room. The minutes of the meeting will contain a more complete record.

- Moderator McConnell-Booher opened the meeting with prayer and then presented a devotion from Matthew 13:44 and used parallels to the life of Saint Nicholas of Myra.
- Those in attendance recited the Vision and Mission Statements.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the agenda as presented.
- Elders spent time in prayer. After making prayer requests known, Elders prayed for those needs.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the Minutes from the last Stated Session meeting and vital statistics from the last month as presented.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the Consent Calendar item, approval of the minutes of the Deacon's October 24, 2023 meeting.
- A written financial report was received from the church treasurer, Mikki Holt.
- The Session wishes to express their gratitude to the Board of Deacons for their outstanding service to First Presbyterian Church and to the Fairbanks Community in general. It was acknowledged that in the recent months more has been asked of them, and they have stepped up to the needs.
- Ruling Elders Paul Reichardt and Ted Riggs volunteered to assist with Communion on January 7, 2024.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to elect Ruling Elders Keith Nore and Brian Sunderland as Commissioners to the upcoming Presbytery Meeting at Woodland Presbyterian Church, in Woodland WA, February 1st to 3rd, 2024.
- Session continued working on the 2024 Budget.
- Written and verbal reports were received from Ministry Teams.
- The meeting was adjourned with prayer, by the Moderator at 9:00 pm.
