What follows is a short summary of the decisions and actions of the Session, at the May 18, 2021 Stated Session Meeting. The minutes of the meeting will contain a more complete record.



The Session of First Presbyterian Church met in the church conference room at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, May 18th.

The meeting was called to order by Acting Moderator, RE Stephanie Rozell, with prayer.

Acting Moderator Rozell led a devotion based on Acts 2:1-40, on the Holy Spirit.

The opening prayer was led by RE Terry Reichardt.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to approve the agenda as presented.

RE Terry Reichardt gave a brief status on the Pastoral Search Committee.

Vital Statistics from April 21, 2021 to May 18, 2021, as well as Minutes from the April 20, 2021 Stated Session Meeting were received. It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to approve them as presented.

There was no correspondence received.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to approve the item on the Consent Calendar. The item was: In April the Personnel Committee approved leave for Pastor Peter, from April 7th to 9th. The Personnel Committee is asking for Session Approval for this leave.

A written financial report from Church Treasurer Christy Repasky was received.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to hold a budget planning meeting in August 2021 to determine priorities that will affect budgeting decisions.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to rescind the COVID Mitigation Plan.

It was decided that RE Barb Page, as member of the COVID Mitigation Team, will notify the Office Manager to notify the congregation via email and newsletter.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to call a Congregational Meeting on June 20, 2021, for the purpose of electing new officers.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to RE Jenna Dreydoppel and RE Jim Williams as Commissioners to the June 22nd to 25th General Assembly Meeting.

RE Jim Williams presented a report on the May Presbytery Meeting.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and to move forward with TE Dembroski's proposal for phase two and phase three of the Transitional Process.

It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to table the motion to proceed with phase two and three until the June Session Meeting.


It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to ask TE Dembroski to submit his report on his phase one interviews by the expected deadline of May 26th.

Action on the approval of the Ministry Team Responsibilities document will be taken at the June 2021 Session Meeting.

Session Ministry Teams presented written and verbal reports.

Elders spent time in prayer. After making prayer requests known, elders prayed for one another and for First Presbyterian, and the meeting was adjourned, in prayer by Moderator Dembroski.




