# ~~~ A Message from the Pastor ~~~

Unique is defined as "being the only one of its kind, unlike anything else." Like "fingerprints" they are unique and one of a kind. In 1880 Henry Faulds suggested, based on his studies, that fingerprints are unique to a human.

It is hard to think of billions of people living and, in the past, that don't share the same fingerprints with you. With endless possibilities, you would believe that one day someone will have the same fingerprints as you. Science says it won't happen. This is also true of your eyes. Apparently, it is one of the most secure ways of identifying you.

The "soul" is in that same category. It is "unique," one of a kind, unlike anything else. C.S. Lewis is one of my favorite authors and theologians. Almost every day I read a devotion from him in a book called "The Year with C.S. Lewis."

Recently I read this incredible devotion about *"The Signature of the Soul"* that I would like to share with you now.

"This signature on each soul may be a product of heredity and environment, but that only means that heredity and environment are among the instruments whereby God creates a soul. I'm considering not how, but why, He makes each soul unique. If you had no use for all these differences, I do not see why He should have created more souls than one.

Be sure that the ins and outs of your individuality are no mystery to him; and one day they will no longer be a ministry to you. The mold in which a key is made would be a strange thing, if you had never seen the key: and the key itself a strange thing if you had never seen a lock. Your soul has a curious shape because it is a hollow made to fit a particular swelling in the infinite contours of the Divine substance, or a key to unlock one of the doors in the house with many mansions. For it is not humanity in the abstract that is to be saved but you - you, the individual reader, John Doe or Janet Doe. Blessed and fortunate creature, your eyes shall behold Him and not another's. All that you are, sins apart, is destined, if you will let God have His good way, to utter satisfaction. ... God will look to every soul like its first love because He is its first love. Your place in heaven will seem to be made for you and you alone, because you were made for it - made for it stitch by stitch as a glove is made for a hand"

What follows is a short summary of the decisions and actions of the Session, at the May 17, 2022 Stated Session Meeting. The minutes of the meeting will contain a more complete record.

The Session of First Presbyterian Church met in the Conference Room at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, May 17<sup>th</sup>.

The meeting was called to order by Moderator Dembroski.

Moderator Dembroski presented a devotion based on Romans 8:26-30.

Elders spent time in prayer. After making prayer requests known, elders prayed for those needs

- Between April 8<sup>th</sup> and April 11<sup>th</sup>, an email vote was conducted. It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to Commission RE Maggie Demers to attend the May Presbytery meeting as a commissioner, and permission to allow David Booher to attend as an observer.
- Minutes from the last Stated Session meeting, the recent Congregational Meeting, and several special session meetings, and vital statistics from the last month were reviewed and approved.
- A Consent Calendar item was approved the review and approval of the Deacons March 2022 Meeting.
- A written financial report was received from Church Treasurer Christy Repasky.
- A discussion on the position of Church Administrator was continued from the March Meeting, and further research is being done.
- RE Stephanie Rozell provided an update on her research into the EPC's GO Center resources and programs for church revitalization. It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to invite Ken Priddy, Executive Director of the GO Center, to come to First Pres to present REBOOT and BOOM Training Events. It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to provide funding in the amount of \$10,000 to cover program costs and travel, and to use earned airline mileage, as best as possible.
- Pastor Peter presented a letter to Session about his time in Fairbanks and willingness to extend his contract. Session discussed a proposal to be presented for Pastor Peter to continue services as Transitional Pastor, on a month to month basis, after his current contract expires in July 2022.
- A decision on the revision of the Schlofeldt Scholarship Policy and Application was postponed until the June Session Meeting.
- Session approved a guest preacher for Sunday June 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Written and verbal ministry team reports were received.
- It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** that Session approve the following vacation days for TE Peter Dembroski: May 26-27, June 1–3, June 12.
- It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to approve the addition of a new outreach, called Youth Street Outreach and Advocacy Program.
- It was **moved**, **seconded** and **passed** to amend the FY2022 budget by adding \$2,000 from the fund balance to the Youth Street Outreach and Advocacy Program budget line.

The next Stated Session Meeting will be held on June 21, 2022 at 6:00 pm, in the Church Conference Room.
