

A New Sermon Series

Starting Sunday, June 4, we will be starting a new sermon series that will take us through the summer season. We will be looking at the narrative arc that runs across all of scripture, but in a way that emphasizes what might not already know about the Bible, and what we can confidently take from Scripture and apply in our daily lives. Our congregation is made up of all sorts of folks, from new Christians and little ones all the way up to biblical scholars who know more about scripture than any pastor in town! I hope that these sermons will give each of us fresh insights into God's Word, as well as invitations to dive deeper into Scripture and how we can utilize it today.

SESSION

What follows is a short summary of the decisions and actions of the Session, at the May 23, 2023 Stated Session Meeting, which began at 6:00 pm in the Church Conference Room. The minutes of the meeting will contain a more complete record.

- Moderator McConnell-Booher presented a devotion from a book entitled: Beyond Words by Frederick Buechner. He then opened the meeting with prayer.
- Those in attendance recited the Vision and Mission Statements.
- The agenda was approved as presented.
- Elders spent time in prayer. After making prayer requests known, elders prayed for those needs.
- Minutes from the last Stated Session meeting and vital statistics from the last month were reviewed and approved as presented.
- There were no correspondence received.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve Consent Calendar items, which included the approval of the Deacons April 25, 2023 Meeting and approving the transfer of membership of TE David McConnell-Booher from FPC to the Presbytery of the Pacific Northwest.
- A written financial report was received from the church treasurer.
- Session discussed methods of streamlining administrative workflow and records sharing. A training workshop for church leaders is scheduled for June 10, 2023 from 10:00 am to noon.
- Because of the dates scheduled for General Assembly, it was moved, seconded and passed to reschedule the 2023 June Stated Session Meeting from June 20, 2023 to Monday June 26, 2023.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to examine new officer candidates at the June 26, 2023 Session Meeting.
- New officer candidate training will be scheduled and facilitated by Pastor David.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the agenda for the June 4, 2023 Congregational meeting.
- Ruling Elder Brian Sunderland presented a verbal and written report on the recent Presbytery Meeting.
- Session received a verbal report from the Vision Team for our GO Center revitalization process.

- Written and verbal Ministry Team Reports were received.
- Vacation Bible School has been scheduled for June 26th through 30th.
- The Finance Team brought the following recommended changes to the 2023 Budget; update the budget to reflect accurately the line items for the Senior Pastor for the remaining 7 months of the year; close out the line items for the Transitional Pastor; and refund the line item for the Sabbatical Fund at \$1,800 for 2023. It was moved, seconded and passed to approve the recommended changes.
- The meeting was adjourned with prayer by Moderator McConnell-Booher.

The next Stated Session Meeting will be held on June 26, 2023 at 6:00 pm, in the Church Conference Room.
