### A Message to the Congregation from Session

At our last Session meeting, we thanked Dr. Donald Baird for his friendship and leadership during the time that he has been with us. As you know, Dr. Baird's contract ended this past month, and his family felt that he was needed at home. Since the COVID 19 restrictions prevent us from meeting, and would require an interim pastor coming to the State to quarantine for two weeks before he could even meet with us, the Session has decided not to seek another interim pastor at this time. A number of elders have volunteered to assist with preaching on Sundays, and this is something our Presbytery encourages. The early church was largely led by elders. Paul, Peter and the other disciples traveled (some more than others) establishing and encouraging new believers, but the elders primarily led the church. Consider these bible passages:

Titus 1:5 The reason I left you in Crete was that you might straighten out what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you.

2 Timothy 4:2 Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season...


James 5:14 Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord.

What follows is a short summary of the decisions and actions of the Session, at the April 21, 2020 Session Meeting. The minutes of the meeting will contain a more complete record.



- Elders attended the meeting over video chat.
- The meeting was opened by Clerk of Session David Dreydoppel based on Isaiah 28:15-18 and Matthew 6:25-34, Moments of Panic.
- Pastor Don led a "Pastor's Study" on Ephesians 2:1-10, about Grace.
- Minutes from the last two Session meetings and vital statistics of the church were received.
- Elders spent a few minutes reviewing the 2020 Three Year Plan.
- Elders decided that a greater focus making contact with members and friends of FPC be made, to "Check In" and assess needs.
- Consent Calendar items were passed as presented. The Consent Calendar items included: Approval of the
  minutes of Deacons Meeting: February 25, 2020 and passage of a Personnel Committee Motion: That the
  amendments to Personnel Policies approved by the Personnel Committee be approved by Session.
- Reports from the Ministry Teams were received.
- Session was notified by Youth Director David McConnell-Booher that Youth Works, the organization which was planning our youth's upcoming mission trip has cancelled all Mission Trips for this summer.
- The Celebration Gathering for Pastor Don was postponed until later in the Summer, when travel restrictions have been listed and he returns to pick up his belongings.
- The upcoming visit by Northwest Presbytery Stated Clerk Dr. Ed Cummings has been postponed until later in the year.
- A written Financial Report was provided to Session, and Church Treasurer was present to answer questions.
- With Pastor Don's departure as our Transitional Pastor, Session has decided to wait until travel restrictions and guarantine recommendations have lifted before considering another Transitional Pastor.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to elect Ruling Elder Jim Aldrich as Moderator until a new Senior Pastor or Transitional Pastor can be found.
- It was moved, seconded and passed to approve and forward the By-Laws of the First Presbyterian Church Congregation, to the next Semi-Annual Congregational Meeting, for adoption.

- The Personnel Committee moved, and it was passed to: Award David McConnell-Booher a bonus of \$1,000 for the extra work he did in the first quarter of 2020.
- Several elders will be assisting Ruling Elder June Champlin and David McConnell-Booher with planning for preaching during the months of May and June.
- David McConnell-Booher is looking for a local pastor to administer Communion on May 10, 2020.
- Elders spent time in prayer. After making prayer requests known, elders prayed for one another and for First Presbyterian.

The next Stated Session Meeting will be held on May 19, 2020 at 6:00 pm in the Church Conference Room or if needed via Video Conference.
